

#### CITY OF HAMMOND FIRE WORKS ORDINANCE

The use of fireworks is prohibited within the Hammond city limits except as follows:

- 1. Between the hours of 5PM and 2 hours after sunset on June 29-July 3 and July 5-July 9
- 2. Between the hours of 10AM and 12 Midnight on July 4
- 3. Between the hours of 10AM on December 31 and 1AM on January 1

#### SUMMER SAFETY TIPS FOR KIDS

- 1. Always CHECK FIRST with your parents if you go anywhere or do anything.
- 2. Be sure to CHECK IN regularly with your parents
- 3. Always TAKE A FRIEND when you play or go somewhere. It's safer & more fun.
- 4. Don't be tricked by people who offer you special treats. Never accept anything from anyone without your parents permission
- Stay SAFE when you're home alone by keeping the door locked; DO NOT open the door if you don't know the person.
- 6. Never go into a public restroom by yourself.
- 7. Don't wear clothes or carry items with your name on the outside, and don't talk to a stranger just because they know your name.
- 8. Be careful playing or riding your bicycle as it get dark. Sometimes it is difficult for people driving cars to see you. Wear reflectors and protective clothing
- Don't be afraid to say NO and GET AWAY from any situation that makes you feel uncomfortable.
  TRUST YOUR FEELINGS and be sure to TELL a trusted adult if something happens that makes you feel uncomfortable.
