HOLIDAY SAFETY TIPS

- ALWAYS call 911 in case of an emergency

CURFEW

Curfew hours for children 15, 16 and 17 years of age. It is unlawful for a child 15, 16 or 17 years of age to be in a public place in the city at any time during the following curfew hours.

- (1) Between 12:00am and 5:00am on Saturday or Sunday
- (2) Between 10:00pm and 5:00am on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday

Curfew hours for children younger than 15 years of age. It is unlawful for a child younger than 15 Years of age to be in a public place in the city after 10:00pm or before 5:00am on any day
