### CITY OF HAMMOND FIRE WORKS ORDINANCE

The use of fireworks is prohibited within the Hammond city limits except as follows:

1. Between the hours of 5PM and 2 hours after sunset on June 29-July 3 and July 5-July 9
2. Between the hours of 10AM and 12 Midnight on July 4
3. Between the hours of 10AM on December 31 and 1AM on January 1

### SUMMER SAFETY TIPS FOR KIDS

2. Be sure to **CHECK IN** regularly with your parents

8. Be careful playing or riding your bicycle as it get dark. Sometimes it is difficult for people driving cars to see you. Wear reflectors and protective clothing
9. Don’t be afraid to say **NO** and **GET AWAY** from any situation that makes you feel uncomfortable. **TRUST YOUR FEELINGS** and be sure to **TELL** a trusted adult if something happens that makes you feel uncomfortable.
